WHO WE ARE – HOW WE OPERATE – WHAT ARE OUR AIMS.

We are a restricted group, primarily made up of permanent and 'long-term stay' residents - normally operating with a maximum playing limit of 20 - and communicating one with another by e-mail or text messaging.

On arranged match-days we will aim to facilitate shared transport arrangements from pre-advised locations, and will finalise pre-competition documentation at our playing venue.

We also make our awards presentations where we play, allowing players the option of going straight home, or socialising as they wish.

We have no commercial arrangements of any sort with any bars or other groups.

All players and invited guests - will be required to pay for each day's play - a Competition Fee and 'Tournament Levy' contribution. All competition fees - other than those allocated for technical prizes which are not won - are returned on the day in the form of cash awards, with no retention for administrative or other costs. The benefits of any discounts received are passed on in full to our members.

'Tournament Levy' contributions - and any technical prize awards which are not won - are used to fund a programme of incentive benefits for 'qualifying' regular supporters - that is separately described.

Within our number limitations - we welcome guests who are introduced by regular supporters, and will only allow those with evidence of current handicap accreditation, to compete for 'handicap influenced' competition prizes - though subject to payment of a 50% competition fee - they may compete for technical awards.

Our key overriding aim - is to provide an opportunity for regular players to develop an ongoing sporting camaraderie - in a totally non-commercial environment.
